Special Factors Behavior, Health, Communication, Learning Media, Assistive Tech Plans, or Specialized Transportation
Annual Goals Based on Impacts of Disability and previous goal progress- recommendation of new goals
Accommodations / Modifications How the student will access curriculum and/or what content will be modified
Extended School Year  Does the student's progress reports show regression / recoupment over breaks? OR Does the student have Predictive Factors?
District / State Assessments Accommodations Based on Present Levels, which assessment and related accommodations are needed?
Service Delivery Who, when, and where will special education services be delivered, also considering extracurricular activities
Least Restrictive Environment  Explain if and why services are not with non-disabled peers, the advantages/disadvantages of that, and what will be done to lessen the disadvantages.
Prior Written Notice Describe any other options considered and reasons why it was rejected
